

Directions to Oak Flat Picnic Ground

GPS: N 34° 59' 50" W 106° 19' 15"

1 Go East on I-40

From I-40 and Tramway Blvd, the distance to the Tijeras exit is about 6.5 miles.

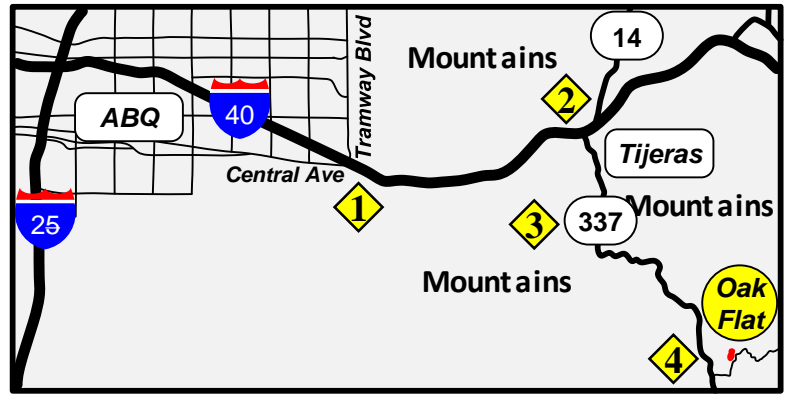
2 Take Exit 175 - Tijeras

On exit ramp, bear right then enter center lane. Go straight at the stop light. This is Highway 337.



3 Go South on Hwy 337 8.6 miles

Please obey the speed limits on this winding road.



4 Turn Left on Oak Flat Rd and go 0.9 miles

Watch for the sign on the right as you come out of the canyon.



5 Turn Left into Oak Flat Picnic Ground

The entrance is the 2nd of the two short roads. Proceed to the end of the entrance.

6 If you are not bringing a telescope:

Follow the signs to the Yucca or Juniper parking areas. Park and follow the lighted red path markers to the observing area.



7 For Yucca turn right then take the first paved road on the left into the parking area. The only restrooms are at Yucca.

8 For Juniper, turn left then take the first right into the parking area.

9 If you are bringing a telescope:

Turn right at end of entrance road and left through the opening in cable fence. There will be signs marking the spot. Follow the little dirt road to the observing field. If arriving after dark, turn off lights and be guided to field.
